

Evan Powis - Saxophonist

One of Australia's finest musicians on the scene, Evan Powis has carved it up with some of the biggest names in the industry.

Fresh back in the country after touring internationally, and throughout his home country, Evan has toured as far away as Thailand, Dubai, Hong Kong, New York and Canada both with the Evan Powis Quartet and as a solo performer in clubs across the globe.

Evan has played in local Sydney Clubs such as Cargo Bar, The Loft, Cherry Jam, The Establishment, The Marble Bar and now Cruise Bar.

Holding a bachelor degree in Performance, from one of Australia's most prestigious music schools - The Sydney Conservatorium of Music, Evan Powis has been studying music since he was five years old.

Performing in jazz groups and stage bands from early on, Evan learnt from greats such as James Morrison and continued on to study at the Conservatorium of Music where he studied with Dale Barlow, Judy Bailey and Craig Scott.

Evan released his first CD 'Imprints on a Dream' in his final year of study and is looking to record his second album.

Regular performances at the legendary Soup Plus in Sydney CBD, has earned Powis a reputation as one of Sydney's finest musicians. Performances with the Mike Knock big band and many contracts with high-class Sydney venues such as the Royal Botanical Gardens and The Sydney Aquarium ensued.

Now Evan performs regularly with Cruise Bar and The Enormous Horns.
