Dear Valued Guests,

The updated roadmap for easing of restrictions relating to COVID-19 has been released by the NSW Government. Current restrictions will be eased as of Wednesday, 15 December 2021.

The safety of all our guests and staff takes precedence. We need to consider Workplace Health and Safety responsibilities, and where practicable, the health and safety of other persons on our premises.

Key factors considered by Cruise Bar, in relation to this matter, include:

1. All reasonable precautions to protect all persons visiting our premises from contracting or spreading the COVID-19 virus.
2. Research findings which overwhelmingly indicate an increased risk of infection and transmission of the virus by unvaccinated persons, referenced in the current Public Health Order under Subclause 1.3(f).
3. The risks associated with easing of travel restrictions, including international and interstate travel.
4. Guests attending the venue and interacting with other guests, and employees.
5. The length of time that COVID-19 will continue in the community, including current variants of the virus.

Cruise Bar has decided to continue to remain accessible to fully vaccinated guests only.

We will review our position on Monday, 31 January 2022, and guests will be updated sooner should the need arise.
